GENÇLER KABLO was founded in 1979 to produce cables and wires. Over the years, the company decided to enhance quality and control costs by manufacturing its own PVC granules. In 1990, investments were made in PVC granulator machinery, expanding the product range to include PVC granules. The same year marked the beginning of supplying cables and wires to the household appliance industry, prompting Gençler Kablo to invest in standards and technology.



By 1995, Gençler Kablo became the first domestic cable and wire producer in Turkey to achieve VDE certification. In 1996, the company started producing 90°C and 105°C heat-resistant cables and wires with VDE certification. In 2001, Gençler Kablo attained ISO certification according to VDE standards and invested in power cord machinery, marking the addition of power cords to their product line. Subsequent investments were made due to the Istanbul factory's insufficient capacity for future growth, leading to the establishment of the Eskişehir factory in 2010.

Continued investments in new machinery and equipment, including full power cord lines and new injection molding machines in 2010, supported the company's growth strategy. Additional investments in 2013, 2015, and 2018 further strengthened the cable and power cord production capabilities. A new warehouse was established in 2020, followed by the addition of a new cable production machine in 2022. Gençler Kablo aims to lead and innovate within the industry.


